

Terms and Conditions of Hampton Wick Royal Cricket Club Lottery.

The Wick – Club 160

Introducing 'Club 160' a new fundraising lottery at the Wick.

Purpose of the fund/Club

By joining and being a member, every month you will be contributing towards, increased and improved coaching at all levels, improved training equipment, and the Wick's Development Fund - ensuring cricket is open and assessable to all. As well as essential ground improvements and many other important causes.

The more Members in Club 160, the bigger the prize. Also, more essential funds are raised. Every single person who signs up will make a real difference.

At our annual dinner we will have a 'jackpot' draw with guaranteed prize money between £500 - £1,000. There are 5 other prize draws every year with cash prizes ranging between £50 and £320 per draw - depending on membership numbers.

Payments and membership of the club.

- 1. The cost per ticket is £10 per month.
- 2. The tickets are paid in advance by standing order.
 - a. Please use your banking app to set this up. Details are given below.
 - b. Or visit your bank giving the details below.
- 3. A separate bank account for the 'The Wick 160 Club' membership has been created. The details are:

- Preferred date is 5th of each month. (Just to help with administration, but not essential).

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- 4. New members must email **secretary@hwrcc.co.uk** and inform the Secretary that they have signed up providing:
 - a. Name
 - b. Email
 - c. Contact number
 - d. Postal Address (optional).
- 5. There is a maximum of 5 tickets any one named individual can buy and be eligible for a Prize. But each family member can also have 5 tickets for example. Members can win more than one prize on any draw if they have more than 1 ticket.
- 6. The administrators will issue each new member with the next sequential member's number. That will be your number each at each draw whilst you are a member.
- 7. If a member leaves, the next member will take the members number who has just left.
- 8. If a winner cannot be contacted within 6 months, the winnings will be placed into Hampton Wick Royal CC funds.
 - a. The club administrators will make all reasonable efforts to contact winners, via phone and email contacts submitted on application to join the club.
 - b. The names of winners shall be posted in the Hampton Wick Royal Cricket Club Pavilion. It is members responsibility to check and make a claim.
- 9. All participants must be over 16. Proof of age may be requested.
- 10. Hampton Wick Royal Cricket Club may change the Ticket price. Members of the lottery/club will be informed not less than 2 months prior to the change.
- 11. Members may withdraw from the club at any time and must have a valid membership at the time of the draw to be eligible for a prize.
- 12. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 'club' if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month and will not be entered into the draw.
- 13. Membership is expected to be continuous. The Committee reserve the right to refuse entry to the club is irregular membership patterns/payments take place.

The Draw

- 14. The draw will take place 6 x a year primarily during the summer months and one at the annual dinner. All dates will be advertised at least 1 month in advance.
- 15. Draws will where possible coincide with other fundraising events. The details of the draw will be advertised in the Cricket pavilion and through other communication

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channels.

- 16. In all instances, 3 winners will be drawn at each draw. Numbered balls without an associated ticket should be removed.
 - a. If however it is drawn another number shall be drawn, until 3 x winning tickets are drawn.
- 17. The draw will take place by taking a numbered ball or token from a concealed item such as a bag with drawn string at the time, or similar apparatus, to ensure the drawer cannot see the selected ball or token.
- 18. A minimum of 2 members of Hampton Wick Royal Cricket Club shall be present during the draw.
- 19. The draw shall be made in the presence of either the Chairman, Honourable Secretary, Honourable Treasurer, President, Chair of the Communications and Fundraising subcommittee of Hampton Wick Royal Cricket Club only.
 - a. In all cases the draw shall take place in the presence of and additional committee members.
- 20. An independent person(s), for the purpose of creating interest and involvement may be asked to select the ball or token from the bag.
- 21. The Chairman of Hampton Wick Royal Crick Club may nominate 24 hours in advance in written form another officer of the club if the named officers are unable to make the draw.
- 22. A minimum of 50 tickets must be sold for the lottery to take place. Our aim is to have 200 tickets sold each month, but there is no maximum number of members.
- 23. If less than 50 tickets are sold and planned draws do not take place members will be offered a refund for payments made during the period no drawers took place.
- 24. Members may wish to leave or suspend payments in until such time a draw is made.

Calculation of prize money and allocations of funds.

- 25. The prize money is as shown below. Only when the next 'club' size threshold is met, shall the prize money increase.
 - a. E.g: 50 or more ticket sales shall mean the lottery can take place.
 - b. Prize money shall remain at the 50 members threshold shown below until 100 members is reached, at which point the prize money shall increase.
 - c. This will repeat at 150, then 200 members. Prize money shall be capped as shown in the 200-membership category irrespective of additional members in the club.
- 26. The Hampton Wick Royal Cricket club committee have the right to increase the payout of any prize, prior to the draw being taken. For example, to promote sales or rise

interest.

- 27. Each draw shall consist of 3 tickets being drawn.
- 28. Once a ticket is drawn, it cannot be drawn again the same draw.
- 29. Each draw shall consist of a 1st 'main' Prize, a 2nd runner up prize and a 3rd place prize.

- 30. The remaining income from ticket sales goes to the Hampton Wick Royal Cricket Club, or any future limited company created for the administration and benefit for Hampton Wick Royal Cricket club.
- 31. Hampton Wick Royal Cricket Club will publish in advance activities and expenditure that the income may support. But has sole discretion on how finds raised are spent.
- 32. If you win a bank transfer will be made to you within 1 month. In exception circumstances on request a check or cash payment can be made.
- 33. The committee may ask for your name to be published at the web or in targeted update newsletters and communication, with the aim to further promoting 'Club 160'.
- 34. In case of any dispute the decision of the committee is final.

Legal information

- 36. The HWRCC 160 Club is a **small society lottery** and had been registered with the London Borough Richmond as required under the gambling Act 2005.
- 37. The Cricket Committee will give 3 months' notice of the termination of the lottery. Members will be asked to stop and standing order payments.

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38. Any money remaining in the account after termination of the 160 Club will be given to Hampton Wick Royal Cricket club, or any future limited company created for the administration and benefit for Hampton Wick Royal Cricket club.
